

## **2021 Fall Semester Self-Health Management and NTU Dormitory Check-in Procedures for NTU Students Arriving from Abroad**

According to the resolution adopted at the 38th meeting held by the NTU Epidemic Prevention Team, all NTU students entering Taiwan from abroad must undergo 7 days of self-health management **outside the university campus**. To protect the health of all residents, students who will live in on-campus dormitories are required to receive a PCR test 3 days before checking in.

### **I. Self-Health Management Procedures:**

- a. Individuals with travel history to “high-risk countries” in the past 14 days must complete 7 days of self-health management in an off-campus self- paid accommodation after 14 days of post-entry quarantine. (The high-risk countries are defined by the Center of Disease Control).
- b. Individuals without travel history to “high-risk countries” in the past 14 days must complete 7 days of self-health management in an off-campus self-paid accommodation after 14 days of post-entry quarantine. Overseas degree students can apply for hotel subsidy according to the information below:

#### **i. On-campus dormitory residents:**

1. Eligibility: current or new residents that are non-local students, who have entered Taiwan during the 2021 academic year, and have paid for their own accommodation in a hotel during the self-health management.
2. Application date: From the announcement of this plan till the end of the 2021 Fall semester.
3. Required documents:
  - a. 2021 Academic Year National Taiwan University Dormitory Resident Post-Entry Self-Health Management Relocation Subsidy Application Form (attached).
  - b. Photocopy of the “Health Declaration and Home Quarantine Notice”.

- c. Photocopy of the receipt of accommodation fee at the hotel.
- 4. Application method: Please bring the required documents to the Student Housing Service Division's office or email to Ms. Feng at [anhua@ntu.edu.tw](mailto:anhua@ntu.edu.tw)
- 5. Maximum subsidized amount is 500 NTD a day, for up to 7 days, in accordance with the provided hotel receipt.
- 6. Receivers of subsidy should abide to the income tax law and other relevant regulations.

ii. BOT Prince House residents:

Students residing in the Prince House can also apply for this subsidy plan with the same subsidy amount. Please proceed in accordance with Prince House's announcement.

- c. Those who have already entered Taiwan and had to be situated in the on-campus self-health management designated zone or BOT single-person rooms for their self-health management shall be relocated to off-campus hotels with the help from the Student Housing Service Division.

II. Dormitory Check-in Procedures:

- a. NTU allows moving into the dormitory from October 1. All students arriving from abroad must take a self-paid PCR test at NTU Hospital 3 days before moving in.
- b. On the day of arrival in Taiwan, students should use the "Quarantine, Testing, Self-Health Management Reporting System" to report:

- c. The University will dedicate staff to notify students about the test date, time and designated location. After the test is complete and the self-health management period is over, students may check into their dormitory.
- d. Those who have not undergone the test, will not be allowed to check-in.
