# [UNDERGRADUATES] Announcement on Dormitory Move-Out and Reallocation for the 2024/2025 Academic Year

### I. Reallocation Eligibility:

- A. All undergraduate students currently residing in Men 1<sup>st</sup> Dorm and Freshman Women's Dorm who are eligible to continue their accommodation for the 2025/2026 academic year.
- B. Students residing in senior dormitories with a student ID starting with B13 who are eligible for continued accommodation for the 2025/2026 academic year.
- C. Undergraduate students living in senior dormitories who are eligible for continued accommodation and are willing to change their dormitory.
- Note: Students in the Second Degree Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program are not required to participate in this reallocation.

#### **II. Reallocation Dormitories:**

Men 2<sup>nd</sup> Dorm (Downtown Campus), Men 3<sup>rd</sup> Dorm, Men 4<sup>th</sup> Dorm (Downtown Campus), Men 5<sup>th</sup> Dorm, Men 6<sup>th</sup> Dorm, Men 7<sup>th</sup> Dorm, Men 8<sup>th</sup> Dorm, Women 1<sup>st</sup> Dorm, Women 2<sup>nd</sup> Dorm, Women 3<sup>rd</sup> Dorm, Women 4<sup>th</sup> Dorm (Downtown Campus), Women 5<sup>th</sup> Dorm, Women 8<sup>th</sup> Dorm, Women 9<sup>th</sup> Dorm, Guo Qing 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor.

Note: Please consider this when selecting preferences.

- Guo Qing 2nd Floor is for female undergraduate students, with two-person rooms. This floor includes Resident Director's office, rooms for handicapped students, and accompanying parents. Some dormitory residents may be different gender students.
- Women's 9th Dorm is a suite with shared bathroom facilities. Each bedroom is equipped with an electric water heater, and residents are responsible for cleaning their own bathroom.
- Women's 4th Dorm is scheduled for renovation of its public spaces in the 2025 academic year.
- Men 2<sup>nd</sup> Dorm is scheduled for structural reinforcement in the 2025/2026 academic year. Residents of Men 2<sup>nd</sup> Dorm who have continued accommodation eligibility for the 2025/2026 academic year can either remain in their original rooms (except for students with IDs starting with B13) or participate in the reallocation.

# **III. Reallocation Timeline:**

A. 25<sup>th</sup> April 2025 (Friday) at 2 pm: Announcement of available bed numbers for the 2024/2025 academic year. B. From 10 am on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2025 (Monday) to 5 pm on 5<sup>th</sup> May 2025 (Monday): Students can apply at <u>https://housing.ntu.edu.tw/move</u> to select dormitory preferences and provide information on roommates they wish to live with. Only one person per group is needed to submit the application above. To complete the application successfully, the applicant must see a confirmation screen and receive a notification email confirming the success of the application. The successful application screen is as follows:

The draw result will be announced on the application system at <mark>2 pm on 13th May (Tuesday)</mark> . Students who wish to change the draw result can follow these steps:
<ol> <li>Same campus exchange: Please find another student or group who is willing to exchange with you, and bring both student IDs to the Student Housing Service office. The application time is from 10 am on 14th May (Wednesday) until 5 pm on 26th May (Monday). The final result will be announced on the website of the Student Housing Service Division at 2 pm on 28th May (Wednesday).</li> </ol>
2. Cross-campus exchange: Please register for the cross-campus draw at https://forms.gle/gX5fysN9NjMGASsP8. The application time is from 10 am on 14th May (Wednesday) until 5 pm on 16th May (Friday). The final result will be announced on the website of Student Housing Service Division at 2 pm on 20th May (Tuesday). (After the cross-campus draw results are announced, you can also proceed with the same-campus exchange.)

- C. The bed allocation results will be announced on the application website at 2 pm on 13th May 2025 (Tuesday).
- D. Students who wish to change the results of the draw can follow the process below:
  - Same campus exchange: Please find another student or group who is willing to exchange with you, and bring both student IDs to the Student Housing Service office. The application time is from 10 am on 14th May (Wednesday) until 5 pm on 26th May (Monday). The final result will be announced on the website of the Student Housing Service Division at 2 pm on 28th May (Wednesday).
  - Cross-campus exchange: Please register for the cross-campus draw at <a href="https://forms.gle/gX5fysN9NjMGASsP8">https://forms.gle/gX5fysN9NjMGASsP8</a> The application time is from 10 am on 14th May (Wednesday) until 5 pm on 16th May (Friday). The final result will be announced on the website of Student Housing Service Division at 2 pm on 20th May (Tuesday). (After the cross-campus draw results are announced, you can also proceed with the same-campus exchange.)
- E. Exchange platform: Students should visit <u>https://ppt.cc/fLTIex</u> to exchange dormitories and check the exchange requirements list at <u>https://ppt.cc/fPQ2Gx</u>.
- F. For undergraduate students who were selected in the March dormitory/renewal draw but did not retain their original bed or make an internal transfer reservation:

If they do not apply online before the deadline, the system will randomly assign a bed.

- G. For students applying for reallocation in senior dormitories: Their original beds will be considered vacant and available for drawing.
- IV. Bed Allocation Rules: The system will randomly assign based on the applicant's needs, whether it is a reallocation with four people together, three people together, two people together, or by oneself to the available rooms. The system will also take into consideration the preferences applied. All dormitories can be selected, but if the number of registered groups exceeds the number of available groups, the exceeded groups will be split into single individuals and randomly assigned to available dormitories.
  - A. As for illustration, If there are 70 groups of available rooms for three people and 90 groups registered for three people, 20 groups will be split into single individuals and randomly assigned to available dormitories.
  - B. Except for some handicapped rooms with a lower bunk and two upper bunk beds, Guo Qing 2<sup>nd</sup> floor are 2-person rooms; the rest of the building are 4-person rooms; single rooms mean that the other three beds still have residents, and only one bed in the room will be used for the reallocation draw.

#### V. Actual Moving Date:

- A. Summer term residents for eight weeks: Around 10<sup>th</sup> August 2025 (Sunday) to 16<sup>th</sup> August 2025 (Saturday), students can move into the new room. Please be aware of the time and availability of the new room.
- B. Non-summer term or Summer term residents for less than eight weeks: 25<sup>th</sup> August 2025 (Monday) is the earliest date you may move into the new dorm.
- C. The date of relocation of each dormitory or bed may vary depending on the building, so please comply with the Resident Director's announcements. If you have any questions, please contact the Resident Director directly.
