

[UNDERGRADUATES] Announcement on Dormitory Move-Out and Reallocation for the 2026/2027 Academic Year

I. Reallocation Eligibility:

- A. All undergraduate students currently residing in Men 1st Dorm and Freshman Women's Dorm who are eligible to continue their accommodation for the 2026/2027 academic year.
- B. Students residing in senior dormitories with a student ID starting with B14 who are eligible for continued accommodation for the 2026/2027 academic year.
- C. Undergraduate students living in senior dormitories who are eligible for continued accommodation and are willing to change their dormitory.

Note: Students in the Second Degree Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program are not required to participate in this reallocation.

II. Reallocation Dormitories:

Men 3rd Dorm, Men 4th Dorm (Downtown Campus), Men 5th Dorm, Men 6th Dorm, Men 7th Dorm, Men 8th Dorm, Women 1st Dorm, Women 2nd Dorm, Women 3rd Dorm, Women 4th Dorm (Downtown Campus), Women 5th Dorm, Women 6th Dorm (Downtown Campus), Women 8th Dorm, Women 9th Dorm, Guo Qing 2nd Floor.

Note: Please consider this when selecting preferences.

- Guo Qing 2nd Floor is for female undergraduate students, with two-person rooms. This floor includes Resident Director's office, rooms for handicapped students, and accompanying parents. Some dormitory residents may be different gender students. Women's 9th Dorm is a suite with shared bathroom facilities. Each bedroom is equipped with an electric water heater, and residents are responsible for cleaning their own bathroom. Women's 4th Dorm is scheduled for renovation of its public spaces in the 2027/2028 academic year.
- Women 1st Dorm and Women 3rd Dorm are scheduled for structural reinforcement in the 2027/2028 academic year. Residents of these dormitories who have continued accommodation eligibility for the 2026/2027 academic year can either remain in their original rooms (except for students with IDs starting with B14) or participate in the reallocation.

(Women 6th Dorm has undergone renovation during the 2025/2026 Academic year. Accommodation fees will be adjusted in the 2026/2027 academic year, with the estimated fee being around NT\$13,400 per semester and about

NT\$6,000 for the summer session.)

III. Reallocation Timeline:

- A. 30th April 2026 (Thursday) at 2 pm: Announcement of available bed numbers for the 2026/2027 academic year.
- B. From 10 am on 4th May 2026 (Monday) to 5 pm on 12th May 2026 (Tuesday): Students can apply at <https://housing.ntu.edu.tw/move> to select dormitory preferences and provide information on roommates they wish to live with. Only one person per group is needed to submit the application above. To complete the application successfully, the applicant must see a confirmation screen and receive a notification email confirming the success of the application. The draw result will be announced on the application system at **2 pm on 18th May (Monday)**. Students who wish to change the draw result can follow these steps:

1. **Same campus exchange:** Please find another student or group who is willing to exchange with you, and bring both student IDs to the Student Housing Service office. The application time is from 2 pm on 18th May (Monday) until 5 pm on 29th May (Friday). The final result will be announced on the website of the Student Housing Service Division at 2 pm on 1st June (Monday).
2. **Cross-campus exchange:** Please register for the cross-campus draw at <https://forms.gle/gX5fysN9NjMGASsP8>. The application time is from 2 pm on 18th May (Monday) until 5 pm on 20th May (Wednesday). The final result will be announced on the website of Student Housing Service Division at 2 pm on 22nd May (Friday). (After the cross-campus draw results are announced, you can also proceed with the same-campus exchange.)

- C. The bed allocation results will be announced on the application website at 2 pm on 18th May 2026 (Monday).
- D. Students who wish to change the results of the draw can follow the process below:
 - Same campus exchange: Please find another student or group who is willing to exchange with you, and bring both student IDs to the Student Housing Service office. The application time is from 2 pm on 18th May (Monday) until 5 pm on 29th May (Friday). The final result will be announced on the website of the Student Housing Service Division at 2 pm on 1st June (Monday).
 - Cross-campus exchange: Please register for the cross-campus draw at <https://forms.gle/gX5fysN9NjMGASsP8> . The application time is from 2 pm on 18th May (Monday) until 5 pm on 20th May (Wednesday). The final result will be announced on the website of Student Housing Service Division at 2 pm on 22nd May (Friday). (After the cross-campus draw results are announced, you can also proceed with the same-campus exchange.)

- E. Exchange platform: Students should visit <https://ppt.cc/fLTlEx> to exchange dormitories and check the exchange requirements list at <https://ppt.cc/fPQ2Gx>.
- F. For undergraduate students who were selected in the March dormitory/renewal draw but did not retain their original bed or make an internal transfer reservation: If they do not apply online before the deadline, the system will randomly assign a bed.
- G. For students applying for reallocation in senior dormitories: Their original beds will be considered vacant and available for drawing.

IV. Bed Allocation Rules: The system will randomly assign based on the applicant's needs, whether it is a reallocation with four people together, three people together, two people together, or by oneself to the available rooms. The system will also take into consideration the preferences applied. All dormitories can be selected, but if the number of registered groups exceeds the number of available groups, the exceeded groups will be split into single individuals and randomly assigned to available dormitories.

- A. As for illustration, if there are 70 groups of available rooms for three people and 90 groups registered for three people, 20 groups will be split into single individuals and randomly assigned to available dormitories.
- B. Except for some handicapped rooms with a lower bunk and two upper bunk beds, Guo Qing 2nd floor are 2-person rooms; the rest of the building are 4-person rooms; single rooms mean that the other three beds still have residents, and only one bed in the room will be used for the reallocation draw.

V. Actual Moving Date:

- A. **Summer term residents for eight weeks: Around 16th August 2026 (Sunday) to 22th August 2026 (Saturday), students can move into the new room.** Please be aware of the time and availability of the new room.
- B. **Non-summer term or Summer term residents for less than eight weeks: 31st August 2026 (Monday) is the earliest date you may move into the new dorm.**
- C. The date of relocation of each dormitory or bed may vary depending on the building, so please comply with the Resident Director's announcements. If you have any questions, please contact the Resident Director directly.
